- Gives you the confidence to play an active leadership role in your local DofE group, helping others to complete their Bronze DofE.



What's involved?

- Introduction to DofE Course (1 day, undertaken locally)
- Online e-learning
- Residential course (two days/two nights).
- 20 hours practical leadership experience with your local DofE group.
- Get your Leader or Development Officer to support your application and become your mentor.

What will I get out of it?

- Skills to help you build your CV and access further training or employment.
- Real leadership experiences.
- Confidence to support others doing their DofE.
- Meet new people, make new friendships.
- Certificate in DofE Leadership (Level 2 qualification).

There are also opportunities to gain qualifications in first aid and expedition leadership after the residential.



What will it cost?
